LA PAZ SUPERIOR COURT, PRO TEM

A.R.S. 22-141 states that upon request of the Presiding Judge of the Superior County in any county the Chief Justice of the State Supreme Court may appoint Judges Pro Tempore of the Superior Court for such county and the appointment is subject to the approval of the Board of Supervisors of the County.

Chief Justice Ann A. Scott Timmer has appointed Jerry Landau as a Judge Pro Tempore to serve the Superior Court in La Paz County. The appointment shall perform duties authorized by A.R.S 12-144 as assigned by the Presiding Judge. The compensation shall be for 20% of the time at 80% of the Superior Court Judge's salary. The appointment is conditioned upon approve of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors

IT IS ORDERED that the honorable Jerry Landau is appointed as a Judge Pro Tempore to serve the Superior Court in La Paz County for a term beginning July 01, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointee shall serve as Judge Pro Tempore subject to the approval of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors.
